The Organising Committee and the sports federations, in most cases the Berlin sports federations, execute the competitions at the European Maccabi Games in close cooperation with one another. Insofar, the Rules & Regulations at hand are a joint product of the EMG2015 Organising Committee and the implementing sports federations.

We hope that the Rules & Regulations at hand will be the basis for sportsmanlike and fair sports competitions and an unforgettable European Maccabi Games Berlin 2015.

1. Organisation

- a. The Equestrian Committee of the 14th European Maccabi Games will be responsible for the Equestrian competitions of the 14th European Maccabi Games.
- b. The Equestrian competitions will be conducted according to the International Equestrian Rules and Regulations (FEI) and according to the EMG2015 Dressage Schedule. The English text will be binding.
- c. Participation in the competition is open to any athlete who is in possession of a Participant Card, issued by the Organising Committee of the 14th European Maccabi Games and registered the Equestrian competitions.

2. Venues & Times

- a. The organiser of the 14th European Maccabi Games will determine the venues and times of the Equestrian competitions and the competitors will be notified accordingly.
- b. The dimension of the competition arena will be 20 x 60 m, type of footing sand.
- c. The Equestrian Committee is authorized to change the venues and times of the competitions these decisions will be final.

3. Teams

- a. Each participating country may enter up to ten competitors for each of the individual events, in total 20. A competitor has to decide in the entry form in which of the Individual competitions he wants to start (Medium or Advanced).
- b. Each participating country may enter up to two teams of min. 3 and max. 4 competitors for the Team competition. Plus max. 4 additional individuals after the team places are fully used. (Max. of 12 riders)
- c. In each category there must be a minimum of three competitors. The results of the individuals are not counting for the team medals but counting for the regular placement.

PLEASE NOTE: The announcement of the competitors is a two step procedure:
(1) Due date 31.10.14, announcement of the number of competitors per skill level by the Maccabi National Federations, (2) Due date 30.6.15, EMG2015 Dressage Registration form containing special information about the horse has to be sent back to the EMG2015 Organising Committee via Maccabi National Federations.

4. System of Competition

1. Dressage: Individual competition will be held in, FEI Challenge Medium and Advanced level. One rider of the individual competition can only compete in one riding level. The Team competition will be held in FEI Challenge Medium level. All riders are allowed to compete in the Team competition. All disciplines and levels may be changed due to the entries.
2. In General competitors are obliged to ride on their own horses. The organiser will be able to offer a limited number of horses to borrow for the event. The amount of borrowed horses is limited to max. 3 per nation.
3. One day before the start of the first competition a fair draw of the borrowed horses for each team or individual athletes will take place after dividing the horses and riders into different groups by their level, measurements of both rider and horse.
4. The conditions under which the horses are borrowed are clearly stated and get send to the athletes at least two months before the start of the competition
5. The competitions will be conducted according to FEI regulations.
Requests to change the level to compete in must be submitted to the Sports Director of the Organising Committee of the 14th European Maccabi Games at least 48 hours before the official opening of the European Maccabi Games 2015.
6. In case a country is able to send and to nominate a team, the riders are obliged to ride the Team competition before they are allowed to ride one of the Individual tests.
